5. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday, 4 May 2023 between the hours of 7am and 10pm.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday 17 April 2023. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
7. Electors should take note that the deadline for new applications to vote by post or to change existing postal or proxy arrangements e.g cancellation or re-direction etc must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown below by 5pm on Tuesday 18 April 2023 if they are to be effective for this election.
8. New applications to vote by proxy must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday 25 April 2023.
9. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday 25 April 2023. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate.
10. The deadline for new applications to be received by the Electoral Registration Officer to vote by emergency proxy at this election is by 5pm on Thursday 4 May 2023.
