TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

Drointon Lane

Stowe By Chartley

NOTICE is hereby given that Staffordshire County Council on 07/01/2025 intends to make an Order the effect of

which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Drointon Lane in Stowe By Chartley from

approximately 304m west of the junction with Broadmore Lane to approximately 560m north east of the junction

with Drointon Lane, Grindley unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle

requires access to properties on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

The order will come into operation on 3rd March 2025 and the said works will commence on or as near

as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28th March 2025.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the track laying works, which it is proposed to

carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
